

Today I would like to share a little secret I have learned in using Photo Booth.

First I'll go over to the Spotlight, type in the word "Photo" and PhotoBooth shows up under Applications. I'll launch PhotoBooth right from Spotlight.

It opens up. And now I'm going to put a card in the window and take a picture of it.

Once it is finished taking the picture. I'm going to click on the picture which appears in the drawer below. I'll click on that picture and you'll notice that it's backwards. So obviously my words being backwards are not very valuable, when I'm doing a school project. So the fastest way for me to flip that picture is to hold down the **Command Key** and type an **f**.

Look at that. It immediately flips the picture over.
