

If you are like me and use Stickies to keep track of random bits of information then this tidbit will certainly come in handy.

As you can see I have 3 stickies already in use. For the sake of example, let's say I just found a piece of information I would like to add to a sticky. The traditional process would go like this:

Step One: Highlight the information

Step Two: Go to Edit > Copy

Step Three: Focus or open Stickies the Application

Step Four: Go to File > New Note

Step Five: Go to Edit > Paste

We certainly could have used keyboard shortcuts to make things a tad quicker, however it would still be at least a five step process. Let's close this note and do it again, but this time I will show you how to do the same thing in two simple steps.

First, highlight the text. By the way, this will work with any text or image you can highlight. It will also work even if the Stickies application isn't currently running.

Second, we hit Command-Shift-Y on the keyboard. As you can see it created a new note with the text that I highlighted. And in only 2 steps.

Quick, simple, and awesome. Just remember Command-Shift-Y.
