

Today I'd like to show you how to use a NoteShare notebook to create a vocabulary list for your students.

In this NoteShare notebook I have the "Call of Wild" . If you go through this notebook you can see all of my chapters. My chapters have the entire book, inside this NoteShare notebook. The easiest way to make a vocabulary list is to go under the word **Outline**. Scroll down to **Special Sections** and click **Show Index Section**. As soon as I do that NoteShare has added an **Index** tab right here on the right. If I click that you can see these are all the things that were just added to this notebook.

One of the very nice features is **Proper Words**, which brings up all of the proper words that can be found in this notebook of "Call of the Wild".

Clicking on this control opens up all of the proper words that begin with an A. And it shows you what page they are on. If I close that back up, I can look at B and I can see there are lots of words in here and what pages they are on. I can also come back to my index and I can look at the **Text**. And here we have all of the **Text**. If I click on a different letter you can see there are quite a few words that begin with the letter M and which page they are on and how many times they appear in the book.

So it would be very easy to now look through this list and create a vocabulary list to go with Call of the wild.
